What to expect on day of clinic:

- Upon arrival today, the client will have height, weight, and head circumference measured and clinical photographs taken of the face.
- The caregiver(s) will meet with the FASD team (occupational therapist, speech/language pathologist, licensed clinical psychologist and licensed mental health therapist) as an initial screening to answer specific questions and for the team to have a better understanding of concerns and what hope to get out of clinic.
- Throughout the day, the client will be evaluated individually with the licensed clinical psychologist, speech/language pathologist and occupational therapist.
- While the evaluations are taking place, the caregiver(s) will complete standardized questionnaires from the professionals as well as meet with the licensed mental health therapist.
- Following these assessments, the team will reconvene and derive a diagnosis and treatment plan and share it with the caregiver(s).

Clinic is an all-day event, starting promptly at 9:30am and ending around 3:00pm. At least one caregiver is required to be present in the building throughout the day. Please bring lunch and beverages for you and your family.
